Stewardship 2021 - "We Are an Offering"

Jesus told a story about a rich man whose land produced a bumper crop, making him even richer. He thought himself secure, but God said to him, *"Fool! This night your soul will be required of you . . ."* Jesus then said, *"So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God."* (Luke 12:13-21)

How do we become *rich toward God*? In the story of the rich fool, our Lord had no problem with the man being rich. But he was judged a fool because he didn't consider God in his decision making about his abundance. He did not consult God about how he might use his windfall to bless others. He was rich in things and poor toward God

- A generous heart that loves and blesses others is *rich toward God.*
